

This 40-minute narrated tour highlights the main attractions of the Milwaukee Holiday Lights Festival, including our three parks – "Community Spirit Park" at Cathedral Square Park, "Santa's Celebration Square powered by We Energies" at Zeidler Union Square and "Christmas Chalet" at Pere Marquette Park.

New this year, Jingle Bus tickets are \$5 per person and MUST be purchased in advance at milwaukeeholidaylights.com. Guests can choose their tour date and time online, with an option to participate in a Spanish tour. Spanish tours will be available every Sunday night, and on December 22 and December 29.

Buses will depart from the Warming House at The Avenue, 275 W. Wisconsin Avenue, where parking is only \$3 for Jingle Bus riders, thanks to Interstate Parking. Please see the information booth in the Warming House for parking validation. Enjoy free treats inside the Warming House, and take in the amenities of the adjacent 3rd Street Market Hall. The market hall offers over a dozen food vendors and tons of free activities like shuffleboard, bags, Jenga, classic Nintendo video games, and more. Plus, check out their Photoverse Selfie Museum and Topgolf Swing Suite.
